Essential Functions

1. Leads and lives with students in cabin groups according to Thousand Pines Outdoor Science School practices for periods of up to 5 days
2. Facilitates operations related to TPOSS
3. Performs duties and/or participates in activities including:
 - a. Outdoor Science School program and curriculum
 - b. Student Safety and Emergency Response

Additional Functions

1. Attends TPOSS Department team meetings
2. Provides support for TPOSS Trail Guides during program sessions
3. Assists TPOSS in any other areas as needed

1. Works well with and relates to TPOSS student age groups
2. Team player
3. Strong communication skills including ability to motivate and discipline students when necessary
4. Demonstrates ability to model desired behaviors on a consistent basis
5. Implementation of our discipline policy: love and logic

Qualifications

1. Minimum of a High School Diploma or equivalent
2. Current Red Cross CPR and First Aid Certifications (condition to being hired, must possess or be signed up for a class. Cert needs to last through the season)
3. Pass a drug test & fingerprinting scan
4. Full agreement with TPOSS mission and values statements
5. Valid driver's license or state issued I.D.

Physical Demands

1. Abilities sufficient to carry out the essential functions of the job including frequent and sometimes strenuous hiking and working in an outdoor setting during four seasons in all weather conditions
2. Must be able to lift minimum of 50 lbs
